1. General terms & conditions

- Please note that tasting samples may only be offered free of charge.
- Serving or distributing alcoholic beverages is not permitted.
- The common standards of cleanliness and hygiene must be complied with (cf. point 3).
- Serving of food containing live insects or similar is only permitted if they are safely packaged.
The packaging must be adapted to the needs of the animals and the outer temperatures.
- Cooking is not permitted on the exhibition area.
- Please provide English information material about your products for participants of the conference.
- If your company does not hold a German approval for the products offered at the conference, please indicate this at your stand.

2. Equipment

- The owner of the stand is responsible for providing enough garbage containers and for the disposal of waste.
- The exhibition booth (6 m²) consists of:
 - a table (1.4 m x 0.7 m) & table cloths (cotton)
 - a pin board (2.0 m height x 1.2 m width, pin-up area 1.5 m (height) x 1.2 m (width))
 - a chair and
 - a power connection
- You are also welcome to bring your own stand system, as long as the dimensions of 3.0 m width and 2.0 m depth are maintained.
- Please note there are no cleaning facilities available to wash cooking equipment and dishes.
- Please contact us if you require storage facilities.
- There is no possibility to cool or heat food at the conference venue.

3. General hygiene instructions and labelling requirements

- The participant assumes the responsibility of keeping common standards of cleanliness and hygiene.
- Labelling obligation: Please label allergens in the food. Can also be indicated orally.
